Clerk-Treasurer Lori Elmore – confirmed the Debt Management reporting requirement on the Indiana Gateway Portal has been completed ahead of the February 28th annual deadline. She further confirmed the City currently has six bonds which a total of outstanding debt in the amount of \$107,295,000.00 as well as three leases with a total of outstanding debt in the amount of \$6,905,167.83.
