

ORDINANCE NO. 2024/20

**AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING FUNDS IN THE
LOCAL INCOME TAX FUND**

WHEREAS, the City of Greenfield, in Section 30.20 of the Code of Ordinance, created a Local Income Tax Fund (“LIT FUND”); and

WHEREAS, the utilization of the LIT FUND shall be for public safety purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Greenfield Board of Public Works and Safety has approved the entry into a contractual agreement between the Greenfield Police Department and American Structurepoint for the submission of a predesigned study for the Greenfield Police Department in an amount not to exceed the sum of \$35,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Greenfield, Indiana believes the appropriation of said monies for the use of public safety is in the best interest of the health, welfare, and safety of the citizens of Greenfield, Indiana.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREENFIELD, INDIANA:

SECTION I

That for the expenses of said City of Greenfield, Indiana, the following additional sums of money are hereby appropriated from the LIT Public Safety Fund Account #2240:
