ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 2014-12

WHEREAS, the City of Greenfield, Indiana owns and operates its own electric utility; and

WHEREAS, the City of Greenfield is a member of the Indiana Municipal Power Agency (“IMPA”); and

WHEREAS, IMPA’s Board of Commissioners adopted a resolution allowing IMPA to purchase excess energy produced by customers of member utilities that own and operate renewable generation sources such as solar panels; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council previously passed Ordinance No. 2014-12 adopting net energy metering for the City of Greenfield’s electric utility; and

WHEREAS, only a few customers of the utility to date have opted to use the net metering tariff; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council has determined that Ordinance No. 2014-12 is no longer necessary and should be repealed, except that customers currently using the net metering tariff shall be allowed to continue using the net metering tariff until December 31, 2034.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREENFIELD, INDIANA:

SECTION I

The findings and determinations set forth in the preambles to this Ordinance are hereby made findings and determinations of the Common Council.

SECTION II

Ordinance No. 2014-12 is hereby repealed and of no further effect.

SECTION III

The Net Metering Tariff made available to customers of the utility under Ordinance No. 2014-12 shall no longer be an available tariff of the utility, except for the customers currently using the net metering tariff, who shall be allowed to continue using the tariff until December 31, 2034.

SECTION IV

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval by the Mayor, and publication as prescribed by law.
