# **UNFINISHED BUSINESS:**

An Ordinance for Appropriations and Tax Rates for the **Ordinance No. 2024/30** Fiscal Year Ending December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2025, with noted amendments; on second reading as introduced by Attorney Morelock. Councilman Jester moved to approve Ordinance 2024/30 as amended, duly seconded by Councilman Riley. Motion Carried Viva Voce.

Larry Silver addressed the members of the Council regarding the Petition he had filed requesting the 20205 budget be reduced by the amount of \$10,000,000.00. He stated many of the signatures had been received during the recent Riley Festival and were not residents of the City of Greenfield. He further encouraged the members of the Council to review the Claims Docket that was presented to the Board of Works for approval twice a month to see what the departments were spending their money on. He said while some were warranted expenses, others perhaps were not.

Ordinance No. 2024/30 - Clerk Treasurer Elmore explained to the members of the Council that the Ordinance had been amended to reflect corrected numbers on the 2025 numbers and percentages. A calculation used on the previous version introduced on September 25<sup>th</sup> had not been correct. Upon correction, the numbers changed slightly but without great significance. Those numbers were read into record by Clerk-Treasurer Elmore for clarification.
