SUMMARY

In 2016, staff worked with a grant administrator to secure one of three IN Main Street Revitalization Grants awarded. Greenfield was the only façade application to be chosen, alongside two streetscape projects.

Outside of the downtown, new commercial and residential construction activity brought excitement with the addition of Kohl's, PetSmart, and a new outlot with multiple stores. The City also worked with Keller Development on a proposed entrepreneur apartment building along the Pennsy that is awaiting a decision on potential Tax Credit Funding.
